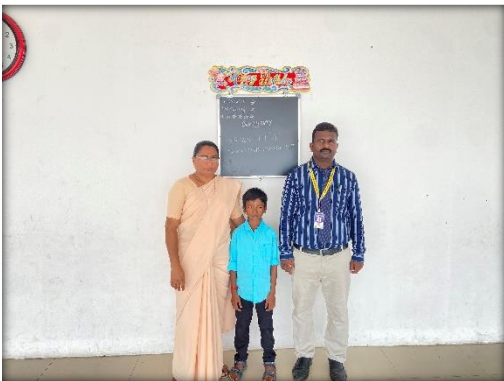

Meetings

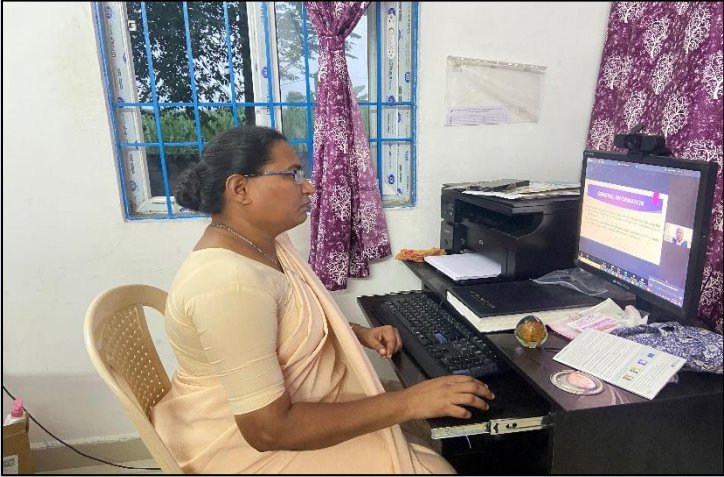

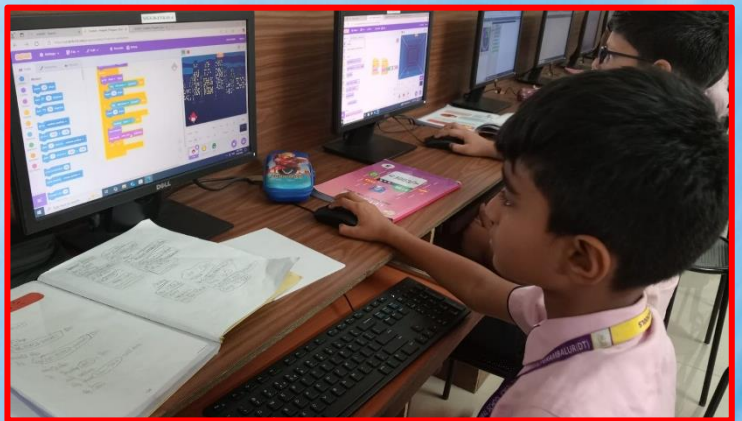

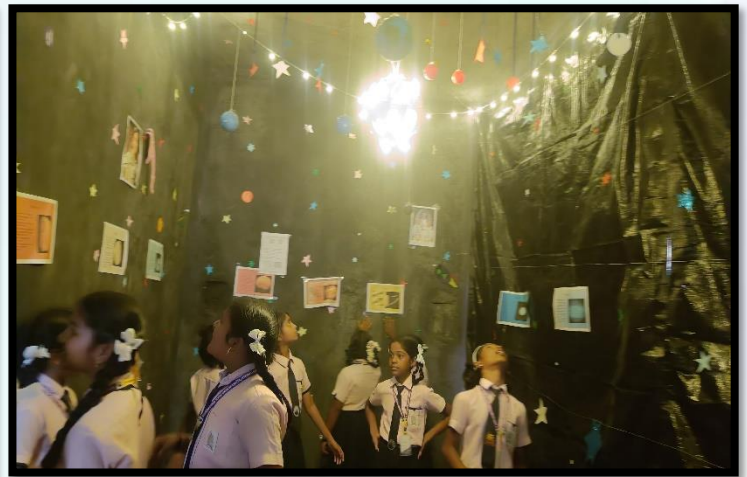
Robotics Class
