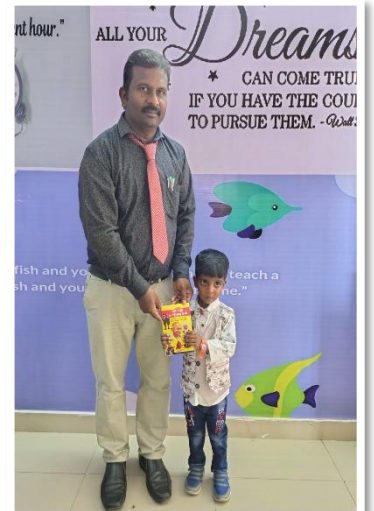

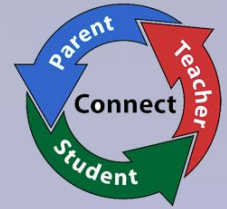
Free Eye Camp

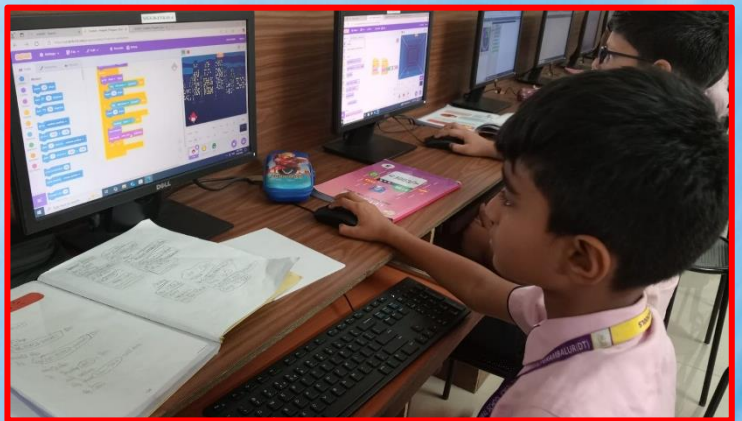

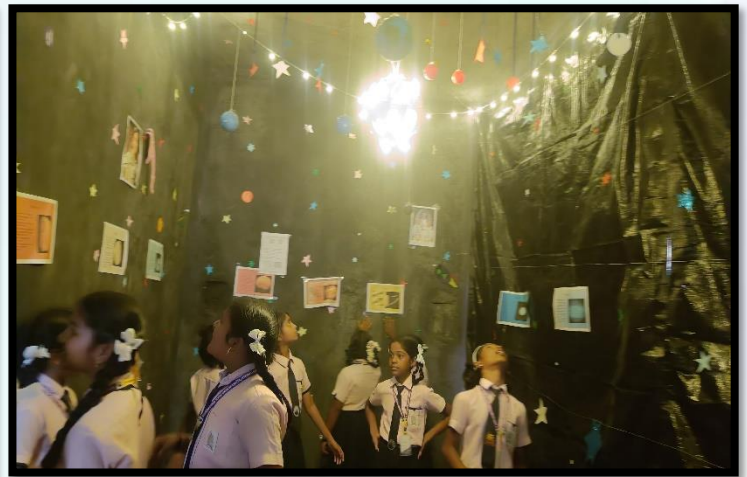
Robotics Class

- ECA classes are started for this academic year 2025-2026 (Classes such as Karate, Silambam, Dance, Skating & Archery etc.)



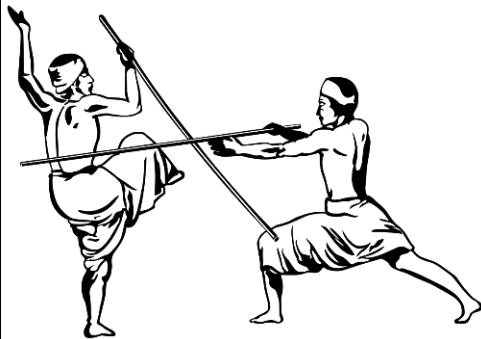
Karate
