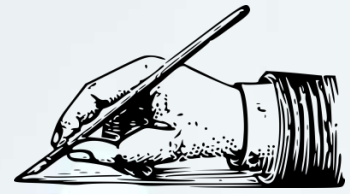

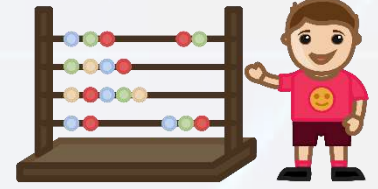

- Remedial classes for English and Tamil on zero period by Tamil and English teachers.



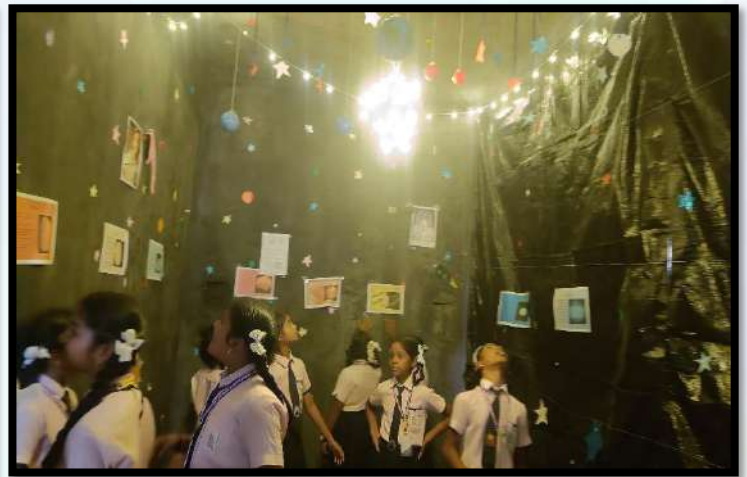
## Robotics Class
