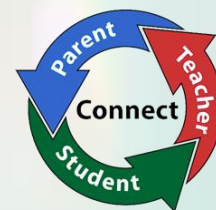


## Parent Orientation Program



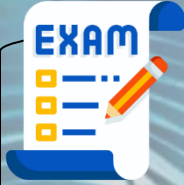

# Meetings

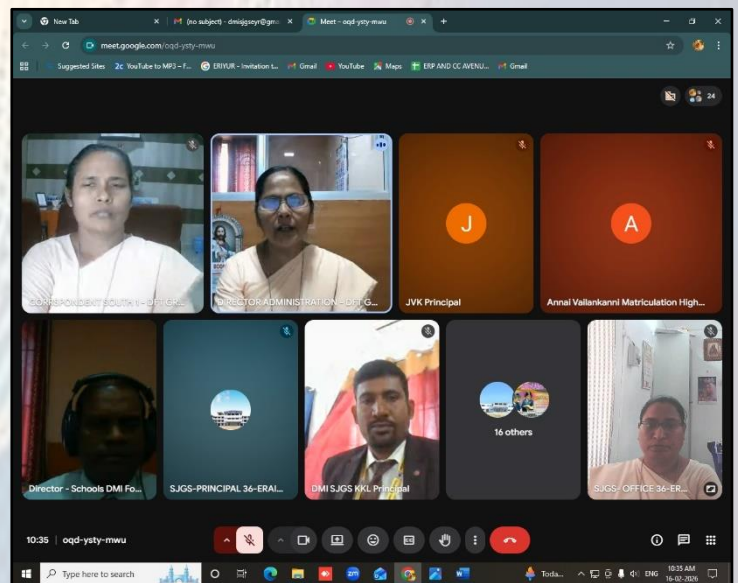


- On 01.02.2026 a meeting was organized by the DFT for all principal and Campus superiors. Our school principal, Campus superior & Vice Principal attended the meeting
