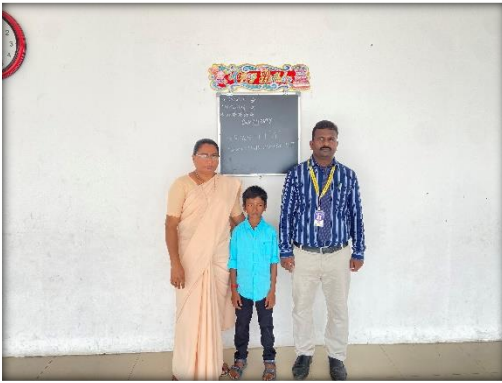

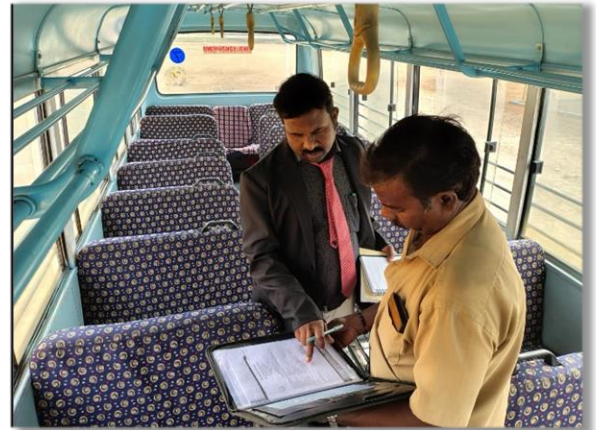

- Morning staff prayer is conducted regularly.





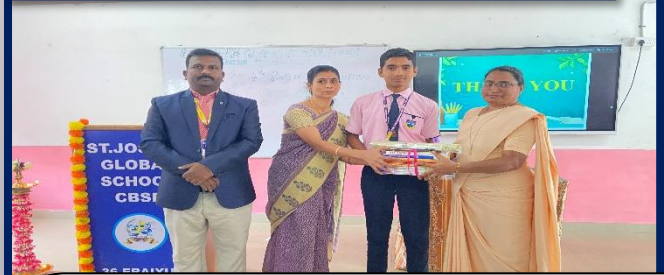
Pongal Celebration

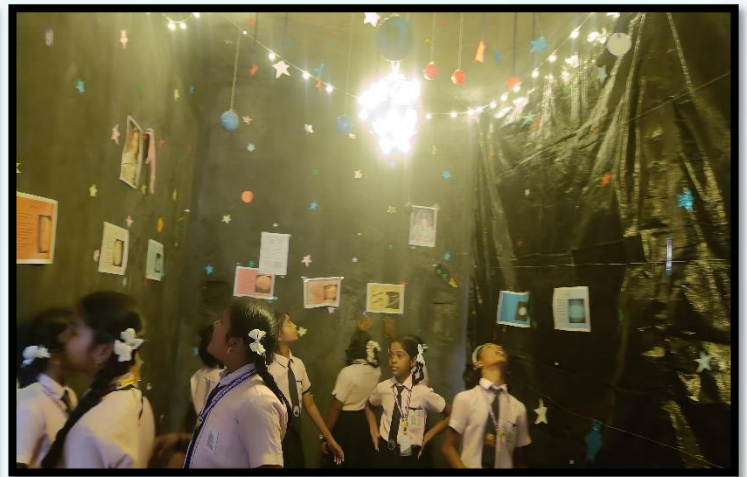
Robotics Class
